WHEREAS, the Ulster County Department of Social Services has inter-municipal agreements pertaining to various programs, and

WHEREAS, General Municipal Law Article 5-G provides that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature, when supported by a resolution, can enter into an inter-municipal agreement on behalf of the County of Ulster, and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of the Ulster County Department of Social Services requests that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized per this resolution, to execute the inter-municipal agreements for the following programs with the municipalities as indicated below:

Community Work Experience Program – City of Kingston, Town of Denning, Town of Esopus, Town of Gardiner, Town of Hardenburgh, Town of Hurley, Town of Kingston, Town of Lloyd, Town of Marbletown, Town of Marlboro, Town of New Paltz, Town of Olive, Town of Plattekill, Town of Rochester, Town of Rosendale, Town of Saugerties, Town of Shandaken, Town of Shawangunk, Town of Ulster and Town of Wawarsing, Town of Woodstock, and

Domestic Violence Unit - City of Kingston, New York State Police Finance, and Town of Ulster, and

WHEREAS, the Human Development and Personnel Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized per this resolution to execute the inter-municipal agreements with the above-referenced municipalities in relation to the Community Work Experience Program and the Domestic Violence Unit as identified in the body of this resolution, as well as amendments to said agreements, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney, and be it further
