WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the Town of Esopus for additional security services at an hourly rate of \$19.68, for the period January 1, 2005 through December 31, 2005, as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney,

and moves its adoption.
