WHEREAS, Ulster County desires to support an alcohol-free and drug-free event following the Saugerties High School senior prom, and

WHEREAS, the Coordinator of Ulster County STOP DWI requests that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature execute an Inter-Municipal Agreement, and any amendments thereto, with the Saugerties Central School District to support a post-prom event at the Wood-N-Wheel Family Entertainment Center in Port Ewen, New York, on May 28, 2010, and

WHEREAS, Ulster County STOP DWI will pay \$650.00 to the Saugerties Central School District to cover a portion of the cost of the event, and

WHEREAS, the Saugerties Central School District will identify Ulster County STOP DWI as a primary sponsor of the event, and

WHEREAS, the Legislative Programs, Education and Community Services Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, now, therefore, be it
