Chairman Donaldson and Legislators Cahill and R.S. Parete offer the following:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 224, Subdivision 8 of the County Law, the Ulster County Legislature appropriated to the Cooperative Extension Association of Ulster County the sum of \$355,300.00 for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2009 to be expended in accordance with budgets submitted to the Ulster County Legislature, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that Cooperative Extension of Ulster County shall render a true and accurate report of its operations for the year 2008 prior to the release of any authorized funds, and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the Commissioner of Finance be and hereby is authorized and directed to pay such funds in equal quarterly installments due on the first day of each period, or in such other manner as may be agreed upon by the parties hereto to the duly elected and properly bonded Commissioner of Finance to the Ulster County Extension Service Association, and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the Comptroller and/or any and all officers of the County of Ulster, their agents and representatives, shall be allowed full access upon reasonable notice and at reasonable times to the books, papers, records and premises of the Cooperative Extension Association of Ulster County during the period that this Resolution is in effect for the purpose of ascertaining the manner in which the above sum of money is being used or applied, and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the above organization agrees to comply with all applicable Federal, State and local regulations including, in particular, any forbidding discrimination by such organization, and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized and directed to sign a memorandum of agreement (subject to the approval of the County Attorney as may be duly approved by Cornell University as agent for the State of New York, outlining the above conditions and methods of payment and directing the above Association to spend the funds only for the purpose set forth herein; requiring an annual report at the end of the year containing therein a true and accurate account of all receipts and expenditures of said association) and an agreement for professional services in the amount of \$355,300.00 with the County of Ulster and the Cooperation Extension Association of Ulster County, in the form as
