FURTHER RESOLVED, that the said organization shall render a verified account of disbursements with certified vouchers attached, refund any unused amount on or before the 31st day of December 2006, and

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Ulster Literacy Association, Inc. shall render a true and accurate report of its operations for the year 2006 on or before January 15, 2007 with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature containing a true and accurate account of all receipts and expenditures, and

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Auditor and/or any and all officers of the County of Ulster, their agents and representatives, shall be allowed full access upon reasonable notice and at reasonable times to the books, papers, records and premises of the Ulster Literacy Association, Inc. during the period that this resolution is in effect for the purpose of ascertaining the manner in which the above sum of money is being used or applied, and
