## Abandonment Of A Portion Of County Owned Property – Owners George F. And Elza Smith – Town Of Gardiner

The Highways & Bridges / Buildings & Grounds / Public Works Administration Committee (Chairman Felicello and Legislators Hathaway, McAfee, Meyer, Stock, Berardi, Donaldson, Provenzano and Zimet) offers the following:

WHEREAS, the County of Ulster has no further use of a County owned parcel of land located in the Town of Gardiner more fully described in the legal description filed with the Clerk of the Legislature, and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Highways and Bridges recommends its abandonment to the adjoining owner, and

WHEREAS, the Highways & Bridges / Buildings & Grounds / Public Works Administration Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.

RESOLVED, that pursuant to Section 118-A of the Highway Law, the County of Ulster abandons the said described portion of County owned land located in the Town of Gardiner to the adjoining property owners George F. and Elza Smith upon payment of the sum of \$2,500.00 as shown on the maps and description as filed with the Clerk of the Legislature, and

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Legislature is authorized to execute a deed conveying such parcel to such persons and any other documents necessary to effect such transfer,

and moves its adoption.
