# Resolution No. 116 April 7, 2009

Amending Capital Project No. 313 For The Purpose Of Construction Of A 15,000 Gallon Diesel Fuel Storage Facility For The Ulster County Area Transit Facility – Amending The 2009 Ulster County Budget – Public Works (Buildings And Grounds)\*

The Economic Development, Housing, Planning and Transit Committee (Chairman Rodriguez and Legislators Bischoff, Loughran, Sheeley, Harris, Roberti and Terrizzi) and the Public Works and Capital Projects Committee (Chairman Loughran and Legislators Decker, Hochberg, Sheeley, Fabiano, Felicello and Roberts) offer the following:

WHEREAS, a 15,000 gallon fuel tank storage facility has been approved in the 2009-2014 Capital Program, in the amount of \$175,000.000 for the Ulster County Area Transit (UCAT) facility, and

WHEREAS, it has become necessary to provide such a 15,000 gallon fuel storage facility to purchase fuel at bulk rates, to reduce costs and ensure availability of fuel when needed, and

WHEREAS, County, State and Federal Funding have been provided in Capital Project No. 313, for design, engineering and other preliminary expenditures in the amount of \$30,000.00 (Federal funds \$24,000.00/State funds \$3,000.00/County funds \$3000.00), pursuant to Resolution No. 271, dated September 10, 2008, and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Transportation requests that Capital Project No. 313 be amended to reduce the design, engineering, and other preliminary expenditures by \$10,000.00, and to fund the remaining costs of \$155,000.00 for site preparation and the purchase and installation of a 15,000 gallon bulk diesel fuel storage facility, and

WHEREAS, funding has been made available in the amount of \$155,000.00 from the 2009 American Recovery and Investment Act (Federal Stimulus) for the project construction, and

WHEREAS, under the Federal Stimulus the County must fund the entire \$20,000.00 for design, engineering, and other preliminary expenditures, and

WHEREAS, the additional \$17,000.00 in County funding will require a transfer from the Contingent Account to the Capital Project, and

WHEREAS, this funding is contingent on the approval of this allocation of Federal UZA 89 Stimulus Funds by the Ulster County Transportation Council, and
