

Adopting Proposed Type II Actions State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) For The County Of Ulster

The Governmental Services, Environmental and Administrative Committee (Chairman Roberts and Legislators Belfiglio, Fabiano, Petit, Ronk, Richard Parete, Robert Parete, Rodriguez and Shapiro) offers the following:

WHEREAS, pursuant to 6 NYCRR § 617.14(e) of SEQRA, all agencies are subject to the Type I and Type II SEQRA lists, but each may adopt its own lists of Type I and Type II actions so long as (1) such lists include all the actions specified in the SEQRA lists, (2) the environmental criteria to be applied to the listed actions are no less protective than the environmental criteria in the SEQRA Type I and Type II actions, and (3) such lists are adopted in accordance with SEQRA criteria, and

WHEREAS, 6 NYCRR § 617.14(f) requires that a public hearing must be held prior to the adoption of such SEQRA local procedures, and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 54 dated March 16, 2010, set the date for Public Hearing on the proposed Type II Actions State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) for the County of Ulster to be held On Tuesday, April 13, 2010 at 6:00 PM in the Legislative Chambers, Ulster County Office Building, 244 Fair Street, Kingston, New York, and

WHEREAS, said Public Hearing was held on Tuesday, April 13, 2010 at 6:00 PM, Ulster County Office Building, Kingston, New York, and

WHEREAS, said Public Hearing was duly advertised in the official newspapers of the County of Ulster together with a supplemental newspaper of the County of Ulster and posted on the signboard maintained by the Clerk of the Legislature situated in the Ulster County Office Building, and

WHEREAS, all parties in attendance were permitted an opportunity to speak on behalf of or in opposition to said proposed Type II Actions State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) for the County of Ulster, and

WHEREAS, the Governmental Services, Environmental and Administrative Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Ulster County Legislature hereby adopted the proposed Type II Actions State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) for the County of Ulster herein annexed and made a part hereof, and, be it further
