

Setting A Public Hearing As Required Under Article 25AA Of Agricultural Markets Law To Be Held On Tuesday, June 15, 2010 At 7:15 PM On Addition Of Lands To Agricultural Districts And Providing Direct Notice To Affected Municipalities

The Economic Development and Tourism Committee (Chairman Maloney and Legislators Frey, Hayes, Petit, Sweeney, Terrizzi, Donaldson, Loughran and Rodriguez) offers the following:

WHEREAS, Ulster County has established a 30-day review period for the addition of lands to an agricultural district, in accordance with New York State Agriculture and Markets Law Section 303-b, and

WHEREAS, the 30-day review period for the addition of lands to agricultural districts as set by the County ended on March 30, 2010, and

WHEREAS, the Agricultural Farmland Protection Board received requests from landowners to include parcels of land in agricultural districts, and

WHEREAS, Agricultural and Markets Law Section 303-b requires a public hearing to be held concerning the addition of one or more parcels of land to agricultural districts, and

WHEREAS, Agricultural and Markets Law Article Section 303-b also requires written notification directly to those municipalities whose territory encompasses lands proposed for inclusion in agricultural districts, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature Public Hearing will be held on Tuesday, June 15, 2010 at 7:15 PM in the Legislative Chambers, Ulster County Office Building, 244 Fair Street, Kingston, New York, and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature be directed to act according to NYS Agricultural Markets Law Section 303-b to cause a legal notice of said Public Hearing to be published and to provide a copy of the hearing notice in writing to all municipalities that have lands proposed for inclusion in Agriculture Districts,
