

Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature To Execute Certain Inter-Municipal Agreements For Domestic Violence Investigators – Department Of Social Services

The Budget and Finance Committee (Chairman Gerentine and Legislators Bernardo, Frey, Hansut, Harris, Maio, Maloney, Gregorius, Lomita, Provenzano and Sheeley) offers the following:

WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the County Executive on behalf of the Ulster County Department of Social Services, and

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Department of Social Services has Inter-Municipal Agreements with the City of Kingston, Town of Ulster, and New York State Police, for investigators for domestic violence matters, and

WHEREAS, New York State's General Municipal Law Article 5-G and Section A3-4 (Y) of the Ulster County Administrative Code provide that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature, when supported by a resolution, can enter into an Inter-Municipal Agreements of behalf of the County of Ulster, and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of the Ulster County Department of Social Services requests that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized, pursuant to this resolution, to execute two Inter-Municipal Agreements for domestic violence investigators for the calendar year 2011, with the municipalities as indicated below:

Town of Ulster Investigator \$108,208.45
NYS Police Senior Investigator \$198,864.00

WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized per this resolution to execute Inter-Municipal Agreements and any amendment thereto, with the Town of Ulster in the amount of \$108, 208.45 and the New York State Division of State Police in the amount of \$198,864.00, to provide Ulster County with the services of domestic violence investigators for the calendar year 2011, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney,
