# In Support Of Re-Assessment Cycle Bill And Full Value Measurement Standard

The Administrative Services Committee (Chairman Provenzano and Legislators Hochberg, Lomita, Terpening, Hansut, Petit and Ronk) and Legislator R.S. Parete offer the following:

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Legislature recently hired a consultant to study Assessment Administration in Ulster County and determine areas of improvement to the current system, and

WHEREAS, this study was completed with input from Local Assessors, Town Supervisors and representatives of the Real Property Tax Service Agency, and

WHEREAS, the general consensus of those involved in the process is that the current system of Assessment Administration is complicated because of the varying levels of assessment from town to town and the lack of a Legislative Mandated Reassessment Cycle and the lack of a Full Value Measurement Standard in New York State, and

WHEREAS, the New York State Assessors Association and the New York State Association of County Directors of Real Property Tax Services have consistently called for such legislation to be adopted, and

WHEREAS, the Administrative Services Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Ulster County Legislature calls on the New York State Legislature to adopt legislation to mandate Re-Assessment by local municipalities on a regular cycle, and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the Ulster County Legislature calls on the New York State Legislature to adopt legislation to develop a Full Value Measurement Standard to be followed by all Assessing Units in New York State, and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature shall forward copies of this resolution to Governor David Paterson, New York State Comptroller's Office, Senate Majority Leader Malcolm Smith, Senate Minority Leader Dean G.
