WHEREAS, pursuant to new Regulation 315.4, the Office of the State Comptroller clearly defines reporting requirements for elected and appointed officials and more clearly defines the process for reporting time worked by those officials; the regulation became effective August 12, 2009, and

WHEREAS, among the requirements for employers are a more detailed Standard Work Day and Reporting Resolution, submission of the resolution to the Retirement System and certification that the resolution was publicly posted, and

WHEREAS, the Governmental Services and Administration Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Ulster County Legislature hereby establishes the following as standard work days for elected and appointed officials and will report the following days worked to the New York State and Local Employees' Retirement System based on the record of activities maintained and submitted by these officials to the Clerk of this body:
