## **Appropriation For The Ulster County Development Corporation**

Chairman Donaldson and Legislators Cahill and R.S. Parete offer the following:

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Legislature has heretofore appropriated the sum of \$200,000.00 for the Ulster County Development Corporation for the purpose of publicizing the advantages of the County for private development so as to improve the business and employment climate within the County pursuant to Section 224 (14) of the County Law, and

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Development Corporation will receive payment in the amount of \$200,000.00, in accordance with the terms specified in an agreement between the County of Ulster and the Ulster County Development Corporation and will return any unexpended funds as of December 31, 2009, along with a certified accounting of expenditures to the Commissioner of Finance, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Commissioner of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to pay to the Ulster County Development Corporation the sum of \$200,000.00, to be paid at the discretion of the Commissioner of Finance, and, be it further

RESOLVED, that such sum be used by the said corporation for expenses incurred in connection with its activities of publicizing the advantages of Ulster County, and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the Ulster County Development Corporation shall render a true and accurate report of its operations for the year 2008 prior to the release of any authorized funding for 2009, and, be it further

RESOLVED, that no County money shall be paid to such organization until a Memorandum of Receipt signed by the principal officer and disbursing officer of such organization, agreeing to comply with the terms of this resolution, is delivered to the Commissioner of Finance, and, be it further

RESOLVED, that said Ulster County Development Corporation shall render a verified account of disbursements, with certified vouchers attached, and refund any unused amount on or before the 31st day of December 2009, and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the Ulster County Development Corporation will submit to the Clerk of the Legislature a detailed report showing all funds received and expended for the progress of its activities by the first day of each month for the balance of the year, and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the above organization will enter into a contract with the County of Ulster, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney,

and move its adoption.
