# **Authorizing The Reacquisition Of Residential Property By Original Owner – Department Of Finance**

WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the County Executive on behalf of the Department of Finance, and

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Commissioner of Finance has requested permission to allow the former owner of Parcel # 54 in the Town of Rochester, tax map number 68.3-3-6.120, to reacquire the property pursuant to the reacquisition policy that was adopted in Resolution No. 261 on September 11, 2003, and

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Commissioner of Finance has requested permission to accept payment in the amount of \$9,901.00 from the former owner of Parcel # 54 in the Town of Gardiner, pursuant to the reacquisition policy of September 11, 2003, and

WHEREAS, this conveyance constitutes a Type II action under section 4.1.5 of the County of Ulster's State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) Type II List that was adopted in Resolution No. 118 on April 20, 2010, and

WHEREAS, as per section 3 of the County's Type II List, this action does not pose as significant potential environmental impact and may be progressed as a Type II action in accordance with 6 NYCRR Part 617 of SEQRA, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of members voting approval; now, therefore, be it
