

Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature to Execute An Inter-Municipal Agreement With The County of Putnam For Boarding Of Prisoners In The Ulster County Jail – Sheriff's Office

The Law Enforcement and Public Safety Committee (Chairman Hayes and Legislators Belfiglio, Ronk, Sweeney, Briggs, Hochberg and Rodriguez) offers the following:

WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the County Executive on behalf of the Sheriff's Office, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 504 of the New York State Correction Law, the New York State Commission of Correction may designate a county to receive and keep in its jail prisoners from another county unable to accommodate some or all of its inmates, and

WHEREAS, New York State's General Municipal Law Article 5-G and Section A3-4 (Y) of the Ulster County Administrative Code provide that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature can enter into an inter-municipal agreement on behalf of the County of Ulster, and

WHEREAS, the County of Putnam wishes to house inmates in the Ulster County Jail at the rate of \$95.00 per day per inmate for the period of April 1, 2010 through March 31, 2011, and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff requests that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to execute an Inter-Municipal Agreement with the County of Putnam for boarding inmates in the Ulster County Jail, subject to the issuance and continued effect of an Order of the New York State Commission of Correction designating the Ulster County Jail as a substitute jail for the Putnam County Jail, and

WHEREAS, the Law Enforcement and Public Safety Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to execute an Inter-Municipal Agreement with the County of Putnam to board prisoners in the Ulster County Jail, for the period of April 1, 2010 through March 31, 2011, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney,
