WHEREAS, the Ulster County Legislature, by Resolution No. 225, adopted July 14, 2005, created the Criminal Justice Council under the auspices of the previous Criminal Justice/Public Safety/Stop DWI Committee, and

WHEREAS, said council was comprised of decision makers from Alternative Sentencing, Sheriff, Jail, Community Corrections, Court Clerk, District Attorney, Mental Health, Probation, Public Defender, Social Services, Youth Bureau, Ulster County Magistrate Association, Ulster County Bar Association, Drug Court and seven members of the community who are not currently employed by Ulster County or any of its contract agencies, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 83, dated March 8, 2006, the council membership was amended to include Stop DWI and a Labor Representative, and

WHEREAS, the council hereby requests amending the membership to reflect new appointments and/or organizational changes in Departments, and

WHEREAS, the Criminal Justice and Safety Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.

RESOLVED, council membership is now amended and shall be comprised of decision makers from Sheriff, Jail, Court Clerk, District Attorney, Mental Health, Probation, Public Defender, Social Services, Youth Bureau, Ulster County Magistrate Association, Ulster County Bar Association, Drug Court, Stop DWI, a labor representative and seven members of the community who are not currently employed by Ulster County or any of its contract agencies, and
