WHEREAS, the addition of a Deputy County Administrator will have a positive effect on the increased demands of the County Administrator's Office, and

WHEREAS, reclassifying the vacant position of Management Analyst to a Deputy County Administrator position will not impact the salary, and

WHEREAS, the Personnel Department has reviewed and prepared an Order and Determination to reclassify the vacant position of Management Analyst (Position Control # 0A123001008) to Deputy County Administrator within the purview of New York State Civil Service Law pending approval of the Ulster County Legislature, and

WHEREAS, the Personnel/Human Services Committee has been polled with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.

RESOLVED, that the Management Analyst position (Position Control # 0A123001008) be reclassified to Deputy County Administrator; and
