WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Social Services requests that the 2009 Ulster County Budget be amended to accept a federal allocation for Child Support Incentive funds in the amount of \$48,612.00, and

WHEREAS, the funding has been awarded to the Ulster County Department of Social Services as the local service district based upon a federal formula which takes into consideration five key child support areas: paternity establishment, support order establishment, current collections, arrears collections and cost effectiveness, and

WHEREAS, the Human Development and Personnel Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.
