WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the County Executive on behalf of the Ulster County Sheriff's Office, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 159 dated June 15, 2010, the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature was authorized to execute an agreement with the Port Authority of New York and New Jersey (Award No. 2008-GB-T8-K083) for the Ulster County Sheriff to receive a grant in the amount of \$165,765.00 to be used for the Port Security Grant Program, whose goal is to prevent, prepare for, respond to and recover from potential terrorist activity on the waterways within the Port of Albany, and

WHEREAS, the funds were to be used on or before June 30, 2011, and

WHEREAS, the money was funded in the 2010 Ulster County Budget but only \$132,365.00 was expended in 2010, leaving \$33,400.00 unexpended, and

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Sheriff now requests that the 2011 Ulster County Budget be amended to include the 2010 unexpended amount of \$33,400.00 (\$25,0505 grant rollover and \$8,350.00 County contribution) for the purchase of equipment to increase the County's surveillance, navigation and dive activities, and

WHEREAS, the Governmental Services and Administration Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, now, therefore, be it
