WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Highways and Bridges has requested that the existing revenues be appropriated in order to proceed with approved flood damage repair, reconstruction and mitigation work, and

WHEREAS, the Highways & Bridges / Buildings & Grounds / Public Works Administration Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of members voting approval.
