WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Public Works is requesting that the 2011 Ulster County Budget be amended to reflect an increase in revenue and appropriations for the purchases and expenses set forth below, and

WHEREAS, the Public Works and Capital Projects Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of members voting approval, now, therefore, be it
