# Approving 2011 Appropriation And Guidelines For Funding The Kingston/Ulster Empire Zone

The Economic Development and Tourism Committee (Chairman Maloney and Legislators Aiello, Frey, Hayes, Sweeney, Terrizzi, Donaldson, Loughran and Rodriguez) offers the following:

WHEREAS, the Kingston/Ulster Empire Zone in Ulster County, established in 1994, has a long record of facilitating new job growth by providing local technical assistance to Empire Zone Certified Businesses within Ulster County, and

WHEREAS, the Kingston/Ulster Empire Zone continues economic development efforts and thus the attraction of new businesses and jobs for the people of Ulster County, and

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Legislature has agreed to approve the initiative for the Kingston/Ulster Empire Zone, in the amount of \$7,500.00 for funding the following efforts:

- Provide staff to conduct Kingston/Ulster Empire Zone operations from the UCDC location, with a target of two days per month;
- Send representative to serve on UCDC Board;
- Work with UCDC to educate businesses regarding Kingston/Ulster Empire Zone benefits;
- Make site visits to existing businesses throughout Ulster County regarding potential zone benefits;
- Attend Red Carpet Team meetings (even if name and form change);
- Consider Zone boundary amendments on a case-by-case basis;
- Prepare annual report of Kingston/Ulster Empire Zone program goals and objectives;
- Follow-up with Zone companies that don't file business annual reports for precertification to provide services; and
- Facilitate access to Zone Capital Corporation Loans for applicable businesses.

Documentation of this initiative must be maintained on file by the Kingston/Ulster Empire Zone and shall be submitted with each invoice, as well as provided to the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature, the Chairman of the Ways and Means Committee of the Ulster County Legislature, and the Chairman of the Economic Development and Tourism Committee of the Ulster County Legislature, and

WHEREAS, this appropriation will be applied to the Kingston/Ulster Empire Zone program for the fiscal year 2010-2011, and
