WHEREAS, \$1,200.00 is requested to replace the floor in one of the Sheriff's boats and \$190.62 is requested to replace flares used during the April 2005 flood time, and

WHEREAS, this money was not available in 2005 and it is now necessary to replace the floor and the flares, and

WHEREAS, the Criminal Justice and Safety Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of members voting approval.

RESOLVED, that \$1,390.62 be reappropriated to A4-1810-4006 expenses, and

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the 2006 Ulster County Budget is hereby amended as follows:
