Authorizing Renewal Of Lease With Town Of Ulster For Ulster County Central Auto Garage – Buildings And Grounds

The Public Works Committee (Chairman Berardi and Legislators Bischoff, Cahill, Dart, Lomita, Stoeckeler, Fabiano, Felicello and McAfee) offers the following:

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Buildings and Grounds has requested the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature to renew the lease with the Town of Ulster for the Ulster County Central Auto Garage for a period of two (2) years, commencing September 15, 2006 through September 14, 2008, at an annual cost of \$20,000.00, which remains the same amount as the previous lease period, and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the Town of Ulster to renew the lease for the Ulster County Central Auto Garage for a period of two (2) years commencing September 15, 2006 through September 14, 2008, at an annual cost of \$20,000.00, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney,

and moves its adoption.
