### Resolution No. 180 June 18, 2013

Urging The New York State Legislature To Act Upon And Approve A Home Rule Request For Senate Bill No. S4516 And Assembly Bill No. A5130 Authorizing Ulster County To Continue The Additional 1% Rate Of Its Sales And Compensating Use Tax For Two More Years

Referred to: The Laws and Rules, Governmental Services Committee (Chairman Roberts and Legislators Donaldson, Fabiano, Loughran, Maio, Robert Parete and Ronk) and The Ways and Means Committee (Chairman Gerentine and Legislators Gregorius, Harris, Maio, Maloney, Provenzano and Rodriguez)

Chairman of the Ways and Means Committee, Richard A. Gerentine, offers the following:

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Legislature requested State legislation allowing the County to continue the additional sales and compensating use tax rate of 1% (one percent) for an additional twenty-four months, from December 1, 2013 to November 30, 2015; and

WHEREAS, such legislation has now been introduced as Senate Bill No. S4516 and Assembly Bill No. A5130 and a formal Home Rule Request has been authorized by the Ulster County Legislature on April 16, 2013 and transmitted to the New York State Legislature; and

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Legislature urges the New York State Legislature to pass the Home Rule Request as proposed; and

WHEREAS, should the Home Rule request not be granted, Ulster County, the City of Kingston and the twenty towns located within Ulster County will experience a budget shortfall of over \$22 million annually, which amount will gravely affect property taxes and the provision of essential services; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Ulster County Legislature hereby urges the New York State Senate and Assembly to adopt, as proposed, Ulster County's Home Rule Request (Request by a Local Government for Enactment of a Special Law), pursuant to Article IX of the Constitution, requesting the enactment of Senate Bill No. S4516 and Assembly Bill No. A5130 entitled "An act to amend the tax law and Chapter 200 of the laws of 2002 amending the tax law relating to certain tax rates imposed by the County of Ulster, to impose an additional 1% sales and compensating use tax,"

and move its adoption.
