

Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature To Execute A Contract With The New York State Department Of Health To Continue The Immunization Action Plan – Amending The 2009 Ulster County Budget – Department Of Health

The Health Services Committee (Chairman R.S. Parete and Legislators Briggs, Stoeckeler, Terpening, Petit, Roberti and Ronk) offers the following:

WHEREAS, the Public Health Director requests that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to execute an amendment to a contract (Contract No. C-023278) with the New York State Department of Health, in the amount of \$91,989.00, to continue the Immunization Action Plan, for the period April 1, 2009 through March 31, 2010, and

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Department of Health administers this program in conjunction with the Healthy People Year 2010 goal, which seeks to meet or exceed a 90% statewide immunization coverage level for two-year-old children, promote the importance of immunization for children and adolescents through education and outreach, collaborate with the County lead-screening program to provide physician education to improve lead-screening practices, increase awareness of the benefits of adult immunization, and support the state's effort to implement a statewide immunization registry (NYSIIS) which oversees the regulatory requirements of registered day care providers, and

WHEREAS, the Health Services Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to execute an amendment to contract (Contract No. C-023278), in the amount of \$91,989.00, and any future amendments thereto, with the New York State Department of Health to continue the Immunization Action Plan, for the period April 1, 2009 through March 31, 2010, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or modified with the approval of the County Attorney, and, be it further

RESOLVED, if funding for this program is eliminated, the program will be eliminated as well,
