WHEREAS, the Ulster County Department of Social Services has inter-municipal agreements pertaining to various programs, and

WHEREAS, New York State's General Municipal Law Article 5-G, and Section A3-4 (Y) of the Ulster County Administration Code provides that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature, when supported by a resolution, can enter into an inter-municipal agreement on behalf of the County of Ulster, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to General Municipal Law, Section 119-n(a), the definition of a municipality includes a school district, and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of the Ulster County Department of Social Services requests that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized per this resolution, to execute the inter-municipal agreement for the following program with the municipality as indicated below:
