Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature To Execute An Agreement With New York State Division Of Criminal Justice Services For The Aid To Prosecution Program – District Attorney

Chairman of the Law Enforcement and Public Safety Committee Richard A. Parete and Deputy Chairman Kenneth Ronk offer the following:

WHEREAS, the County of Ulster and the State of New York had previously entered into an agreement for the Aid to Prosecution Program, in the amount of \$56,700.00, for the purpose of improving the prosecution of repeat violent and serious felony offenders, the term of which expired March 31, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the State of New York has now appropriated funds to continue such program for an additional year, in the amount of \$56,700.00, for the period April 1, 2012 through March 31, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the District Attorney is requesting that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to execute an agreement (NYS # C128065), and any amendments thereto, in the amount of \$56,700.00 with the NYS Division of Criminal Justice Services to renew the Aid to Prosecution Program; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to execute an agreement (NYS # C128065), and any amendments thereto, in the amount of \$56,700.00 for the Aid to Prosecution Program with the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Legislature, or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney, Chairman of the County Legislature, and Chairman and Deputy Chairman of the Law Enforcement and Public Safety Committee; and, be it further
