WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the County Executive on behalf of the Department of Finance, and

WHEREAS, the County Commissioner of Finance has requested permission to accept a bid for a parcel of County-owned property as hereinafter described, which was acquired by the County by reason of non-payment of taxes and has previously been offered at a Public Auction, and

WHEREAS, said parcel was listed as # 128 of the 2011 Public Auction, described as 1.30 acres, vacant land, in the Town of Wawarsing, section, block, and lot number 58.2-1-10, has unpaid taxes in the amount of \$2,285.93 dating back to the year 2007, and

WHEREAS, the prospective purchaser of Parcel # 128 has bid \$780.00 for the property, which amount falls within the upset price range as determined by the County's Real Property Tax Service Agency, and

WHEREAS, the prospective purchaser shall be responsible for the 2011-12 school tax and all subsequent tax levies, and

WHEREAS, this conveyance constitutes a Type II action under section 4.1.5 of the County of Ulster's State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) Type II List that was adopted in Resolution No. 118 on April 20, 2010, and

WHEREAS, as per section 3 of the County's Type II List, this action does not pose a significant potential environmental impact and may be progressed as a Type II action in accordance with 6 NYCRR Part 617 of SEQRA, and

WHEREAS the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of members voting approval, now, therefore, be it
