Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature To Execute Certain Intermunicipal Agreements For Domestic Violence Investigators – Department Of Social Services

The Health and Human Services Committee (Chairman Frey and Legislators Harris, Maio, Petit, Ronk, Briggs, Loughran, Parete, and Stoeckeler) offers the following:

WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the County Executive on behalf of the Ulster County Department of Social Services, and

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Department of Social Services currently has Intermunicipal Agreements with the Town of Ulster, and New York State Division of State Police, for the provision of domestic violence investigators, and

WHEREAS, New York State's General Municipal Law Article 5-G and Section A3-4 (Y) of the Ulster County Administrative Code provide that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature, when supported by a resolution, can execute an intermunicipal agreement of behalf of the County of Ulster, and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of the Ulster County Department of Social Services requests that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized, pursuant to this resolution, to execute two Intermunicipal Agreements for domestic violence investigators for the term January 1, 2012 through December 31, 2012, with the Town of Ulster and New York State Police at a cost as indicated below:

Town of Ulster Investigator \$111,455.00 NYS Police Senior Investigator \$204,830.00

and

WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of members voting approval, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to execute Intermunicipal Agreements, and any amendments thereto, with the Town of Ulster in the amount of \$111, 455.00 and the New York State Division of State Police in the amount of \$204,830.00, to provide Ulster County with the services of domestic violence investigators for the term January 1, 2012 through December 31, 2012, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney, and be it further

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RESOLVED, that in the event that funding for this program is eliminated, then the program will be eliminated as well,

and moves its adoption.
