

Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature To Enter Into Agreements With The NYS Office Of Children And Family Services - Social Services

Chairman Donaldson and Legislators Provenzano and R.S. Parete offer the following:

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Legislature is required to authorize the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature to enter into agreements with the NYS Office of Children and Family Services and to authorize the Commissioner of Ulster County Social Services to enter into agreements with contract agencies for the year 2006, and

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Legislature must approve the 2006 Resource Allocation Plan.

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to enter into agreements with the NYS Office of Children and Family Services and the Commissioner of Ulster County Social Services be authorized to enter into agreements with contract agencies for the year 2006, and

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Resource Allocation Plan be filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature and after it has been so filed, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to execute such plan along with Commissioner of Ulster County Social Services for the year 2006,

and moves its adoption.
