WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the County Executive on behalf of the Ulster County Department of Finance, and

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Commissioner of Finance has requested permission to accept payment of the full amount of back taxes on certain parcels of real property acquired by the County by reason of non-payment of taxes, and

WHEREAS, the previous owner has a contract of sale for the parcel listed below known as tax map number 56.60-1-18 in the Town of Esopus, and will pay (1) the full amount due at closing, in the amount of \$127,632.59 (which includes unpaid 2009 general, 2008-09 school and 2009-10 school taxes for 56.60-1-18.200) if paid by January 31, 2010, in the form of a certified check, cashier's check, cash or money order, and (2) deed recording fee in the amount of \$310.00, and

WHEREAS, the 2010 property tax bill is not included in the above amounts and is due and payable to the Town of Esopus Tax Collector, and

WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of members voting approval, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Ulster County Commissioner of Finance is authorized to accept payment as above set forth with respect to the following, and The Ulster County Attorney is authorized to hold such deed in escrow until payment is received,
