WHEREAS, the Ulster County Legislature is an equal branch of the Ulster County government charged with initiating policy and legislation, and

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the Ulster County Legislature to oversee updates to the Administrative Code of Ulster County as well as other enabling legislation, and

WHEREAS, the Administrative Code was adopted in 2008 and effective January 1, 2009, and

WHEREAS, the Governmental Services, Environmental and Administrative Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, the Ulster County Legislature shall create a committee to make recommendations to the full body for the update and amendment of the Administrative Code, and be it further

RESOLVED, the committee shall consist of two members from the Majority, two members of the Minority as well as Majority (2) and Minority Counsels, and be it further

RESOLVED, the committee shall report back to the Legislature no later than November 1, 2010,

and move its adoption.
