WHEREAS, the Ulster County Commissioner of Public Works requests funds for reconstruction and rehabilitation of County roads, bridges, culverts, embankments, tunnels, viaducts, underpasses, waterways, drainage works, dikes, bulkheads and incidental improvements and expenses for damages caused by Tropical Storm Irene, and

WHEREAS, President Obama issued a major disaster declaration for the State of New York, which authorizes the release of Federal funds from the Federal Emergency Management Agency to reimburse New York municipalities up to the amount of seventy-five (75%) percent for eligible costs associated with the reconstruction and rehabilitation of damages incurred, and

WHEREAS, New York State authorizes up to the amount of twelve and one-half (12.5%) percent through the New York State Office of Emergency Management, and

WHEREAS, this program will be managed by the Ulster County Commissioner of Public Works, and

WHEREAS, based upon examination by the Ulster County Legislature, the County's funding of this Project constitutes a Type II action as defined under Sections 2.33 of the County of Ulster's State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) Type II List, which was adopted pursuant to Resolution No. 118 dated April 20, 2010, and

WHEREAS, Ulster County has determined that this funding action does not pose a significant potential environmental impact and may be progressed as a Type II action in accordance with 6 NYCRR Part 617 of SEQRA, and does not require any determination or procedure under SEQRA, and

WHEREAS, the Public Works and Capital Projects Committee has met and reviewed the request with a majority of the members voting approval, and
