

Resolution No. 226 August 20, 2013

Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature To Enter Into A Permit With The State Of New York, Division Of Military And Naval Affairs For Use Of The Memorial Area Of The Kingston Armory – Department Of Public Works (Buildings and Grounds)

Referred to: The Public Works and Capital Projects Committee (Chairman Fabiano and Legislators Briggs, Maloney, Parete, and Roberts)

Chairman of the Public Works and Capital Projects Committee, Dean J. Fabiano, and Deputy Chairman John Parete offer the following:

WHEREAS, this Resolution has been submitted by the County Executive on behalf of the Department of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, Ulster County owns and maintains a Vietnam Veterans Memorial which is located on the grounds of 300 Flatbush Avenue in the City of Kingston; and

WHEREAS, it has become necessary to move the Memorial from its current location; and

WHEREAS, as the owner of the Memorial, Ulster County has a duty to continue to maintain it and its surrounding area; and

WHEREAS, the State of New York, Division of Military and Naval Affairs has offered space at the Kingston Armory Memorial Area, located at 25 Kiersted Avenue in the City of Kingston, where the Ulster County Vietnam Veterans Memorial can be installed; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to enter into a permit agreement, and any amendments thereto, with the State of New York, Division of Military and Naval Affairs for space at the Kingston Armory Memorial Area for the installation and maintenance of the Ulster County Vietnam Veterans Memorial, for a term of five (5) years, as filed with the Clerk of the Legislature, or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney,

and moves its adoption.
