WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the County Executive on behalf of the Department of Public Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Transportation has recommended approval of an updated Ulster County Area Transit Substance Abuse Policy in accordance with 49 CFR Part 655 and 49 CFR Part 40; and

WHEREAS, in order to comply with the Federal Transit Administration regulations UCAT is required to have a written substance abuse policy in place which is continuously reviewed and updated as needed; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Ulster County Legislature hereby approves and re-adopts the Ulster County Area Transit Substance Abuse Policy; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to sign the Ulster County Area Transit Substance Abuse Policy, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature, or as modified by the County Attorney,
