WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the County Executive on behalf of the Ulster County District Attorney, and

WHEREAS, the County of Ulster and the State of New York had previously entered into an agreement for the Aid to Prosecution Program, in the amount of \$68,600.00, for the purpose of improving the prosecution of repeat violent and serious felony offenders, the term of which expired March 31, 2010, and

WHEREAS, the State of New York has now appropriated funds in the amount of \$61,800.00 to continue this program for an additional year, for the period April 1, 2010 through March 31, 2011, and

WHEREAS, the District Attorney is requesting that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to execute an agreement (C108056), and any amendments thereto, with the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services, in the amount of \$61,800.00, to renew the Aid to Prosecution Program, and

WHEREAS, the Law Enforcement and Public Safety Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to execute an agreement (C108056), and any amendments thereto, in the amount of \$61,800.00, with the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services for the Aid to Prosecution Program, for the period April 1, 2010 through March 31, 2011, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified by the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, if funding for this program is eliminated, County participation will be reviewed by the Budget and Finance Committee,
