WHEREAS, the Drinking Water Enhancement Program funds will be used for staff positions that will enable the Department of Health to improve its ability to oversee and implement the public drinking water supply program, including new programmatic and regulatory requirements, as well as other initiatives in the area of drinking water protection, and

WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to execute a contract (Contract No. C-026490), and any amendments thereto, with the New York State Department of Health to renew the Drinking Water Enhancement Program for the period April 1, 2010 through March 31, 2015, in the amount of \$218,573.00 for the initial year, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, if funding for the program is eliminated, the program will be eliminated as well,
