WHEREAS, the department has been unable to recruit replacement staff during these leaves because of the temporary nature of the appointments, and

WHEREAS, the department has proposed an emergency measure to overcome this problem during the maternity leaves that are occurring and planned, and

WHEREAS, the department has proposed that two positions be created, effective September 1, 2004, for the purpose of hiring permanent staff during these leaves, and

WHEREAS, the department has committed to making this transaction budget neutral, and

WHEREAS, the Director of Ulster County Mental Health has contacted the members of the Mental Health / Public Health / Residential Services Committee of the Ulster County Legislature regarding this said request, and

WHEREAS, the Personnel / Human Services Committee of the Ulster County Legislature has reviewed said request with a majority of its members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee of the Ulster County Legislature has reviewed said request with a majority of its members voting approval.
