WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the County Executive on behalf of the Department of Planning, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 249, dated August 13, 2008, which authorized the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature to submit an application for a Regional Waterfront Revitalization Plan under the Environmental Protection Fund Local Waterfront Revitalization Program in the amount of \$100,000.00, and

WHEREAS, Ulster County's Hudson River waterfront municipalities contain a significant percentage of the County's population as well as important natural and historic resources that will benefit from a regional approach to visualizing their growth area, and

WHEREAS, Ulster County has received notice from the New York State Department of State that it has been awarded \$100,000.00 to develop a Regional Waterfront Revitalization Plan, and

WHEREAS, the required \$100,000.00 local share will consist of in-kind services performed by Ulster County Planning Department staff, and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Planning Department requests that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to execute a contract (NYS Agreement #C006981), and any amendments thereto, with the New York State Department of State for the preparation of the County of Ulster Regional Waterfront Revitalization Plan, with state funding in the amount of \$100,000.00 for the initial contract period of April 1, 2010 through March 31, 2012, and

WHEREAS, the Economic Development and Tourism Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, now, therefore, be it
