Legislator Carl Belfiglio and Legislator Kenneth Wishnick offer the following:

WHEREAS, the County of Ulster Employs over 1,700 full and Part Time Employees and Contract Personnel; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the Taxpayer and the Ulster County Legislature to have an accounting of all employees whether they are full time, part time, department heads, deputy department heads or contract employees including all new hires, department Transfers, retirements and appointments; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section C-25 of the County Charter, the County Executive has authority relating to the organization and reorganization of Departments and except as provided by law, responsibility for supervising the appointment and dismissal of County employees; and

WHEREAS, In the course of daily business of oversight, personnel may be separated, retire, hired or appointed; and

WHEREAS, such changes have a direct effect on the total spending throughout the County fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of this resolution to ensure the Legislature has a full accounting of employees on a monthly basis; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the County Personnel Director shall furnish on a monthly basis to Clerk of the County Legislature an accounting by title all new hires, separations, retirements, department transfers; and be it further

RESOLVED, the accounting will include County Department, hire date, separation date, appointment effective date (if different from the hire date), transfer date, transfer to and from department; and be it further

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RESOLVED, that the County Executive is hereby requested to direct the County Personnel Director to comply with this request; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Legislature shall furnish such report to the Chairperson and Deputy Chairperson of the Health and Personnel Committee within five days of the receipt thereof and shall cause the same to be published on the Legislature's website as soon as practicable; and be it to be entered as public record for the benefit of transparency and accountability to the Ulster County Legislature and for the benefit of the general public; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the first accounting report be furnished to the Clerk of the Legislature by the first day of every month starting on March 1, 2013,

and moves its adoption.
