Among such powers and duties, but not by way of limitation, it shall have the power: to conduct studies and investigations in furtherance of its legislative functions, and in connection therewith, to obtain and employ professional and technical advice, appoint citizens' committees, commissions and boards, subpoena witnesses, administer oaths, and require the production of books, papers and other evidence deemed necessary or material to such studies or investigations;

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Special Committee to draft a proposed local law and/or policy for Capital Projects Oversight for the County of Ulster, and

WHEREAS, the proposed local law and/or policy will address all aspects of the capital project procedure, the capital projects themselves and the financial criteria of the capital projects, and

WHEREAS, the Public Works and Capital Projects Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Government Operations and Efficiency Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that this Special Committee shall consist of members from the Public Works and Capital Projects Committee, members from the Government Operations and Efficiency Committee, and a community member; Counsel to the Legislature is hereby directed by this resolution to advise this Special Committee, and be it further

RESOLVED, that a six (6) member Special Committee composed of the following individuals:

are hereby appointed by the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature to this Special Committee pursuant to the Administrative Code Section A2-6(A). "Powers and Duties of Chairman. There is hereby assigned to the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature the following specified administrative powers and duties on behalf of the Ulster County Legislature and his or her performance thereof:

(4) To appoint members of boards, commissions and advisory committees, except where such appointments are required to be made by the County Legislature or the County Executive under state or federal law or the Ulster County Charter," and pursuant to the Ulster County Charter Section C-16 and the Administrative Code Section A2-11: "Members of all citizens' committees, commissions and boards appointed pursuant to § C-11K of the Charter shall serve at the pleasure of the County Legislature. They shall serve without compensation other than for actual and necessary expenses within appropriations made therefor, unless otherwise provided by resolution of the County Legislature. The Chairman of the County Legislature shall be a member ex-officio of all such committees, commissions and boards," and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Special Committee will hereby be known as the Special Committee to Draft a Proposed Local Law and/or Policy on Capital Projects,

and move its adoption.
