WHEREAS, the District Attorney's Recruitment and Retention Program, Project No. LG08-1381-D00 is Federal Pass-Thru State funded and will be administered for the period, starting January 1, 2009 through December 31, 2009, and

WHEREAS, the Criminal Justice and Safety Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to execute an agreement and any future amendments thereto and, being said contract (T088636) in the amount of \$24,218.00, with the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS) to participate in the District Attorney's Recruitment and Retention Program for the period of January 1, 2009 through December, 2009, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney, and, be it further

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and moves its adoption.
