The Economic Development and Tourism Committee (Chairman Maloney and Legislators Frey, Hayes, Petit, Sweeney, Terrizzi, Donaldson, Loughran and Rodriguez) offers the following:

WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the County Executive on behalf of the Department of Public Transportation, and

WHEREAS, the 2010 Ulster County Budget included funding from the New York State Department of Transportation (Public Transportation Bureau) for the Statewide Mass Transportation Operating Assistance Program (STOA) in Ulster County to operate a public transit system for year 2010, and

WHEREAS, Ulster County Area Transit (UCAT) and other public transit operators maintain and operate public transportation systems in the County, and

WHEREAS, Ulster County receives operating assistance funding from STOA based on a formula and distributes the funding to UCAT and other public transit operators based on the number of passengers transported and the number of miles driven for each route in the County's public transit system, and

WHEREAS, the current STOA budget allocated to public transit in Ulster County, based on 2009 statistics, is \$770,000.00, and

WHEREAS, the County has exceeded its budgeted drawdown capacity from STOA as a result of reporting an increase in the passenger/mileage activity for the years 2009 and 2010, and

WHEREAS, the estimated current amount now needed for year 2010 is \$1,220,000.00 for distribution to UCAT and other public transit operators, and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Transportation is requesting to amend the 2010 Ulster County Budget to accept \$450,000.00 in additional State funding to reimburse UCAT and other transit operators for the year ending December 31, 2010, and

WHEREAS, the Economic Development and Tourism Committee has met and reviewed said funding with a majority of its members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee has met and reviewed said funding with a majority of its members voting approval, now, therefore, be it
