

Authorizing An Extension For The Report From The Special Committee To Study And Review The Environmental Needs Of Ulster County To September 12, 2007

The Ways and Means Committee (Chairman Lomita and Legislators Bartels, Berardi, Gregorius, Provenzano, Zimet, Cummings, Gerentine and Noonan) offers the following:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 39 dated January 18, 2007, a Special Committee was appointed to study and review the environmental needs of Ulster County, and

WHEREAS, a seven (7) member Special Committee was created for the purpose of studying and reviewing these needs, and

WHEREAS, this Committee shall report back to the Ulster County Legislature with its recommendations, and

WHEREAS, due to the volume and complexity of the issues involved, it is now necessary to request an extension for the submission of said report to September 12, 2007, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.

RESOLVED, that the Special Committee to Study and Review the Environmental Needs Of Ulster County, be authorized an extension to report its findings to the Ulster County Legislature, to September 12, 2007,

and moves its adoption.
