WHEREAS, the reimbursable County portion of this allocation is \$156,432.00, and

WHEREAS, the Resource Allocation Plan covers Youth Development and Delinquency Prevention, Special Delinquency Prevention, and Runaway Homeless Youth Act programs, and

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Youth Board has met and reviewed all submitted proposals and has made its recommendation to the Director of the Youth Bureau, and

WHEREAS, the Governmental Services and Administration Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of members voting approval, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Ulster County Legislature hereby approves the Ulster County Youth Bureau's 2012 Resource Allocation Plan in the amount of \$184,776.00, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, if funding for this plan is eliminated, County participation will be reviewed by the Ways and Means Committee,
