WHEREAS, the position is currently set at a grade level that is lower than the Clinical Supervisor of a clinic unit, and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Ulster County Mental Health Department requests that the Fiscal Officer be classified at a level equal to the Unit Leader of a clinical unit and be reclassified from a Grade 18 to a Grade 19, and

WHEREAS, the Health Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Personnel Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.
