WHEREAS, pursuant to Local Law No. 17 of 2007, Section 1. Establishment of the Department [b]: "Prior to December 31, 2008, the Coordinator of the Department of the Environment shall be appointed by the Ulster County Legislature and shall serve at the pleasure of the Ulster County Legislature; and such appointment shall not extend beyond December 31, 2008. Thereafter, commencing January 1, 2009, the Coordinator of the Department of the Environment shall be appointed by the County Executive subject to confirmation of the County Legislature and such appointee shall serve at the pleasure of the County Executive," and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ulster County Local Law No. 17 of 2007, the County Executive has appointed Amanda LaValle as Coordinator of the Department of the Environment for the County of Ulster, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.

RESOLVED, that the Ulster County Legislature confirms the appointment of Amanda LaValle to the position of Coordinator of the Department of the Environment for the County of Ulster,

and moves its adoption.
