

Confirming County Executive's Appointment Of The Coordinator Of Stop DWI For The County Of Ulster

The Ways and Means Committee (Chairman Lomita and Legislators Cahill, Dart, Gregorius, Provenzano, Rodriguez, Cummings, Gerentine and Noonan) offers the following:

WHEREAS, pursuant to New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law §1197, the County Executive has appointed John Miller as Coordinator of Stop DWI, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section C-132(D) of the Ulster County Charter and Section A45-5(D) of the Administrative Code: *“Transfer of functions, duties and personnel; other County departments, boards, offices and agencies. Additional appointments to be made by the County Executive. The County Executive shall appoint the head of any administrative unit not provided for in the Charter, subject to the confirmation of the Legislature. All such appointees shall serve at the pleasure of the County Executive and have such powers and duties as shall be provided by law, except where such law shall be inconsistent with the Charter within the limits prescribed in Article 4 of the Municipal Home Rule Law,”* and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.

RESOLVED, that the Ulster County Legislature confirms the appointment of John Miller to the position of Coordinator of Stop DWI for the County of Ulster,

and moves its adoption.
