## Increasing The Labor Rate At Central Auto From \$30.00 Per Hour To \$50.00 Per Hour – Purchasing

The Administrative Services Committee (Chairman Cahill and Legislators Bischoff, Kraft, R.S. Parete, Stoeckeler, Aiello and Every), the Efficiency, Reform and Intergovernmental Affairs Committee (Chairman Bischoff and Legislators Bartels, Liepmann, Rodriguez, Shapiro, Busick and Cummings) and Legislator Shapiro offer the following:

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Purchasing Agent has recommended an increase in the labor rate at Central Auto from \$30.00 per hour to \$50.00 per hour, and

WHEREAS, the County has not adjusted its rates in over ten years and seems to be under charging for labor at Central Auto, and

WHEREAS, the Administrative Services Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Efficiency, Reform and Intergovernmental Affairs Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.

RESOLVED, that the labor rate at Central Auto be increased from \$30.00 per hour to \$50.00, as recommended by the Ulster County Purchasing Agent, and

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Ulster County Legislature's Administration Services Committee and Efficiency, Reform and Intergovernmental Affairs Committee explore and support a policy that would update and increase the amount charged for labor at Central Auto for State charge back accounts,

and moves its adoption.
